



## **DIRECTIONS TO MARLOWE COTTAGE IN CALDBECK**

### **From the East/South:**

1. Leave the M6 Motorway at Junction 41.
2. Take the B5305 for Wigton & Caldbeck. Continue for approximately 6 miles.
3. When you see a sign left to **Hesket Newmarket and Caldbeck**, take this road, which will effectively take you all the way to the cottage.
4. First you will pass through the hamlet of Millhouse and then the village of Hesket Newmarket. The road bears right to Caldbeck just beyond the village green.
5. Caldbeck is about 1.5 miles further on from Hesket Newmarket and the road will take you through the centre of the village, past the Church (set back on your right) and then the Post Office/Store also on your right.
6. You will then see the Oddfellows Arms PH immediately ahead of you.
7. Carry on, keeping to the **left** of the pub (which has roads on all sides).
8. Proceed up the hill out of the village centre – there are fields on both sides at this point - and you will see ahead on the LH side the bell tower of the village school, which is at the top of the rise.
9. Marlowe Cottage is situated on the left, just below the school and immediately beyond a white painted cottage (Park View), to which it is attached.

### **From the West:**

1. From the A595 Cockermouth – Carlisle road, take the B5305 for Penrith – this is the main Wigton to Penrith road.
2. After about 4 miles, there is a cross roads. Turn right onto the B5299.
3. Continue up the steep hill and follow for 2 miles, across a cattle grid, past the Lake District National Park sign.
4. Immediately there is another cross roads.
5. Turn left down the hill into Caldbeck village.
6. Continue past the pub on the left to a T-junction. Turn right and follow from (8) above.

### **From the North:**

1. Leave the M6 motorway at Junction 42 and take the 4<sup>th</sup> exit which is signposted to Dalson. Follow this road all the way to Dalston (at the staggered cross roads at Durdar, proceed straight on).
2. You join the B5299 at the southern end of Dalston, just after you have crossed the River Caldew (narrow bridge). Turn left here (Bridge End Service Station is on your left, pub on your right) and follow the signs to Caldbeck.
3. Follow the B5299 right through Welton and on towards Caldbeck.
4. Follow from point 3 – “from the West”.

### **Satellite Navigation:**

If using satellite navigation, please enter a postcode of **CA7 8HF** into your device to find the cottage.
